- Must be able to lift small children (for after the pandemic)
- Must be able to sing, dance, smile, and hold a small child all at the same time, and have fun doing it
- Professional vocal training is a plus
- Strong sight-singing skills are a plus

- Some education in music theory is a plus
- Fun, positive, energetic, outgoing personality
- Ability to work well independently

- Ability to play in instrument is a plus, but not required (please indicate instrument in your cover letter)
